

# *Year 10* GCSE / IGCSE Scholarship Application Process

Thank you for your interest in our Year 10 GCSE/IGCSE Academic Scholarship Programme. Kindly submit all required documents under both the Admissions Application and Scholarship Application Checklists in a timely manner. All documents must be original copies, accompanied by official English translations where applicable.

## Admissions Application Checklist

Submit a school Admissions Application form
Submit your school admissions Application Fee Payment as soon as you submit your admissions application
Schedule your CAT4 Test (application fee payment required)
Schedule your 30-min. interview (application fee payment required)
Submit current year's progress report
Submit last year's final grades/academic report
Applicant: birth certificate
Applicant and Parent/Guardian: passport photo taken within six months up to date of application (JPEG)
Applicant and Parent/Guardian: FIN/NRIC (front and back) or valid re-entry permit

Submit your Year 10 / IGCSE Scholarship Application form (more details below)
Parent/Guardian: Submit tuition fee invoice for applicant's current school showing payment/s for 2024-2025

## About the Scholarship Application Form

The scholarship application form consists of three main sections:

- 1. Applicant Information
- 2. Parent/Guardian Information
- 3. Scholarship Application Section (for applicant)

#### About the Assessment for Admissions Consideration

All scholarship candidates will need to take a CAT4 test and have an interview with a member of our leadership team. These will be organised by the Brighton College (Singapore) admissions team upon application.

Interview: A one-on-one conversation with a Senior Leader to explore your academic interests and goals. This will be held in person at Brighton College (Singapore) or online.

CAT4: The CAT4 takes approximately 90 minutes to complete and will be taken in person at Brighton College (Singapore) or online in a quiet, supervised environment if the candidate is not in Singapore. This test does not require any prior preparation.

The CAT4 (Cognitive Abilities Test – Fourth Edition) is a widely used standardised assessment that helps us understand how students think and learn best. Rather than testing knowledge of school subjects, it measures natural reasoning ability across four key areas:

- · Verbal Reasoning working with words and language
- Non-Verbal Reasoning recognising patterns and solving visual problems
- Quantitative Reasoning working with numbers and logic
- · Spatial Ability visualising shapes and how they fit together

#### Results Notification

All scholarship candidates will be notified of their admissions and scholarship application outcome following the completion of the scholarship application process.
