Uniform Policy - Senior School, Years 7 to 13





School Uniform

Consistency ('uniformity') within the expectations of pupil uniform can provide a haven from pressures and expectations on teenagers to wear the 'right' thing, the 'right' way, or to be adapting constantly to changing styles and trends. The rules below will be enforced by staff for these reasons.

General Rules for all pupils:

- Pupils should be dressed smartly and should take pride in their appearance at all times.
- Games kit should only be worn for P.E / Games lessons, when pupils should wear the College games kit (not match-day or representative shirts).
- No ostentatious appearance allowed.
- Blazers or jackets must be worn at all times when in smart uniform. No cardigans or long jumpers which hang below the jacket are permitted.
- When wearing smart uniform, shoes must be formal in style, flat and black leather; no leather trainers or shoes with coloured laces / stitching. Sixth Form pupils may wear brown or navy shoes. Leather shoes must be kept well-polished.
- For sports activities and lessons, pupils must wear sports trainers rather than any alternative footwear such as sliders, plimsolls, or casual shoes.
- Socks should be ankle-length, plain, black and unbranded for pupils in Years 7 to 11. Sixth Form pupils must wear smart, ankle-length, non-sports socks. Tights should not have rips, holes or ladders.
- No jewellery may be worn for games.
- Shirts / blouses must be tucked in.
- When worn, ties must be done up properly, tied at the collar.
- Hair must be neat in style and natural in colour - no ostentatious hair styles or colours are allowed.
- Accessories such as eyelash extensions are not permitted for any age group. Nail varnish may only be worn by those in the Sixth Form in accordance with the rules set out in those dress codes.
- Pupils must be clean shaven.
- A refillable (non-plastic) water bottle should be used.
- School bags should be plain, dark in colour and without branding. Pupils have the option of using the Brighton College (Singapore) rucksack.
- **Pupils must fully adhere to Uniform A OR Uniform B. Pupils are not permitted to select elements across the uniforms.**

The College uniform code applies to pupils from when they arrive on-site to when they leave the site, and on school trips as directed by their trip leaders.

School Uniform Lists

Uniform A

Year 7 - Year 11	Sixth Form
- White open-neck reverse blouse, to be tucked in. - Plain, black V-neck jumper (optional). - College knee-length skirt. - College blazer. - Plain black / neutral-coloured tights OR black ankle socks. Shoes must be smart in style, flat and black leather; no leather trainers or shoes with colours laces / stitching Jewellery - no piercings, except ear lobes: one pair of stud earrings. A single discreet necklace and bracelet may be worn. - Pupils in Years 7 and 8 must have hair tied back. In Year 9 onwards, hair may be worn down provided it is neat and well-groomed. Make-up is not permitted for pupils in Years 7 to 9. Pupils in Years 10 and 11 may wear subtle make-up to conceal blemishes. Make-up should be natural in appearance and must not be used to enhance facial features. Nail varnish is not permitted. Hat for outdoor play and activities: wide-brim hat and/or baseball cap	‘Smart and business-like’ - A dark matching skirt/dress/trouser suit, including blazer <i>Note: Must be of suitable structured material and formal in nature, suitable for attending a formal job interview</i> Skirts or dresses - must always reach to the top of the knee - A blouse or a shirt with collar and sleeves must be worn and tucked in. Jumpers (optional) should be plain coloured, V-neck and smart in design. These should not be chunky, patterned, made of fleece material, or have a zip-up neck. The blouse collar and top button must be visible. - Plain, dark or neutral tights / socks (in keeping with outfit.) - Smart dark leather shoes in black, navy or dark brown - heels should be no more than two inches high; no stilettos, boots, no leather trainers or shoes with coloured laces / stitching. Jewellery: piercings are only permitted to the ears, with up to two earrings permitted per ear. These should be studs or earrings with a drop of not more than 1cm from the earlobe; a single, discreet necklace and bracelet may be worn; a single ring may be worn; no ankle bracelets or other jewellery is permitted. Make-up is permitted but must be discreet, natural in appearance, and not used to enhance facial features Accessories such as eyelash extensions are not permitted for any age group. Nail varnish of a subtle, neutral colour, may be worn. Nails should not be overly long or hinder in the participation of school activities.

Optional Items	Navy Crested Games Bag	Hard wearing duffel bag with a section for soiled clothing.
	BCS Navy Running Shorts	Optional shorts; can be worn instead of skort.

School Uniform Lists

Uniform B

Year 7 - Year 11
Plain white short sleeved shirt, to be tucked in.
College tie, tied at the collar.
Plain, black V-neck jumper (optional).
College boys blazer.
Trousers: Pupils in Years 7 and 8 are required to wear shorts. Pupils in Year 9 onwards may opt for charcoal trousers.
Plain, smart black socks.
Smart black shoes; no boots, leather trainers or shoes with coloured laces / stitching.
Hair should be neat and tidy, above the collar in length, and not shaven. Hair bands must not be worn.
No piercings or other jewellery are permitted.
Hat for outdoor play and activities: wide-brim hat and/or baseball cap



Sixth Form
‘Smart and business-like’
A dark matching suit, including blazer
<i>Note: Must be of suitable structured material and formal in nature, suitable for attending a formal job interview</i>
Trousers - must be of classic design and not of a ‘skinny fit’. Black/dark belts with no large buckle may be worn. - Smart formal shirt (must be plain, fine pinstripe or fine check)
College tie
Smart black / brown shoes; no boots, leather trainers or shoes with coloured laces / stitching
Jumpers should be plain coloured, V-neck and smart in design. These should not be chunky, patterned, made of fleece material, or have a zip-up neck. The shirt collar and tie must be visible.
Hair should be neat and tidy, above the collar in length and not shaven. Hair bands must not be worn.
Jewellery: a single, discreet necklace and bracelet may be worn; a single ring may be worn. No piercings or other jewellery may be worn.
